The following topics were discussed:

- Fire Department – Chairman Bill Reilly discussed the purchase of Chief’s Car which will be approved at the February 5, 2018 meeting.
- Discussed setting a public hearing for a new local law to establish a Business Improvement District – vote to set public hearing deferred until the February 5, 2018 meeting.
- Discussed the Bernard Street Gas Station canopy and curb cut on Bernard Street.
- Discussed LIRR/MTA proposed station improvements.
- Building Department:
 - The Board agreed to support Croxley Ale House’s application to the State Liquor Authority allowing a DJ.
