CAPITAL PROJECT INCREASE (137 & 146 MAIN STREET) - Upon a motion made by Trustee Barrett and seconded by Trustee Priestley, it was unanimously,

RESOLVED (**#2018-08-25**), to increase the capital project for the purchase and conversion of 137 and 146 Main Street to a parking lot from \$1,061,205 to \$1,186,110.40 the increase to be funded by an interfund transfer from the General Fund.

- SUNY Homecoming September 23rd 4 signs will be placed around the Village, in the following locations: Village Green, 5 Corners, Train Station, Thomas Powell Blvd. at Bethpage Road
- Building Department:
 - The Board discussed the AT&T proposal but felt they weren't considering a 20% cut in revenue.
 - Walter Dunn Engineering Village engineers for traffic issues

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- Cameron Engineering:
 - Park Reconstruction Victor's, 5 Corners
 - Make south side of Front Street walkable, expand the scope of the contract at the September 5th meeting.
- Highway Department:
 - No additional 12 hour spots in Parking Lot 2
 - Move taxis to Jackson Avenue parking lot. Neighbors to be notified.
 - Lot 3 reconstruction is scheduled for completion by the end of September.
 - Friday's rain & water by DPW yard, capacity of recharge basins.
 - Lot 2 & 3 fence costs
- Water Department:
 - High pressure zone getting closer to completion
 - Training for Water Superintendent Geary Gerhardt was approved
- Code Department
