



As no other matters were formally voted upon, and after discussion concerning various matters to be considered at the January 18, 2005 Board Meeting, it was moved by Trustee Dorfmeister, seconded by Trustee Rachiele to adjourn to executive session to discuss legal matters. Motion carried, all voting 'Aye'.

The Board discussed an inquiry from the Nassau County Office of the District Attorney concerning the District Attorney's investigation of possible criminal felony offenses by former Mayor Joseph Trudden, as reported to the District Attorney by the Office of the State Comptroller in relation to their Financial Audit of the Village in 2003. The District Attorney indicated that they had the ability to obtain court Orders of Protection for interested parties. A lengthy discussion ensued where it was noted that at least 10 Village employees/officials have claimed to have been harassed over the past year by Mr. Trudden. It was moved by Trustee Langon, seconded by Trustee Rachiele to direct the Village Attorney to forward such names to the District Attorney for Orders of Protection. Motion carried, all voting 'Aye'.

After no further business, it was moved by Trustee Langon, seconded by Trustee Rachiele to close the meeting. Motion carried, all voting 'Aye'.
