

**REGULAR MEETING – BOARD OF TRUSTEES March 28, 2003**

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Farmingdale was held in Village Hall, 361 Main Street, Farmingdale, New York at 5:30 P.M. on March 28, 2003.

The Mayor opened the meeting with the pledge to the flag.

The Village Clerk discussed the 2003 / 04 Tentative Budget for General & Water Funds, indicating a tentative tax rate of 15.43, and no change to the water rates. The proposed expenditure for the General Fund \$4,804,066., of which 2,983,376. would be paid for through real property taxes. Increased debt service of \$580,681. is equivalent to the amount of the tax rate increase. The Village Clerk also discussed various budget schedules. The following individuals commented:

In response to their inquires, the Village Clerk advised on the increase in the total assessed valuation, review of new Nassau County assessments, permissiveness of transferring surplus Water Funds to the General Fund, and reduction in General Fund surplus if the planned sale of Village property on Hynes Court is cancelled.

After no further discussion those present exited and the Board convened for dinner at Melanies Restaurant, 169 Main Street. At the suggestion of the Mayor, the Village Clerks presentation of a quarterly report was tabled.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:20 P.M.
