

**REGULAR MEETING – BOARD OF TRUSTEES April 9, 2003**

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Farmingdale was held in Village Hall, 361 Main Street, Farmingdale, New York at 7:30 P.M. on April 9, 2003.

The Mayor opened the meeting with the pledge to the flag.

An extensive discussion ensued concerning the 03 / 04 Tentative Budget. It was moved by Trustee Sotis, seconded by Trustee Kelly to amend the tentative budget pursuant to Section 5 – 508 of Village Law as follows:

Expenses:

General & Water Funds A9010 & F9010, New York State Retirement System premium rate – 5%.

Revenue:

General Fund – Receipt of \$40,000. A0400.44785 (reimbursement by FEMA of Presidents Day Storm Event).

Motion carried, all voting 'Aye'.

The Village Clerk reported that the Village auditor indicated that it was permissible to transfer 03 / 04 New York State multimodal funds of \$250,000. anticipated to be obtained from Senator Hannon and Assemblyman Conte, to be utilized by the General Fund.

It was moved by Trustee Giminaro, seconded by Trustee Denauski to authorize the Village Clerk to itemize the 2003 / 04 tax bill to show a highway bond assessment. Motion carried, all voting 'Aye'.

The Village Clerk distributed copies of a quarterly activity report and discussed same (see exhibit A). After a lengthy presentation and no suggestions, it was moved by Trustee Kelly, seconded by Trustee Sotis to accept the report. Motion carried, all voting 'Aye'.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:55 P.M.
