The Mayor opened the regular meeting with the pledge to the flag.

After a brief discussion regarding the April 26, 2005 minutes, it was moved by Deputy Mayor Rachiele, seconded by Trustee Dorfmeister to approve the Minutes of April 26, 2005. Motion carried, all voting 'Aye'. Trustee Giminaro abstained.

It was moved by Deputy Mayor Rachiele, seconded by Trustee Langon to approve the parade permit for the Farmingdale Village Fire Department for the Memorial Day Parade. Motion carried, all voting "Aye".

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the second floor of the building at 273 Main Street and order the owner of the property to restore offices to that location. Motion carried, all voting "Aye".


