

TRUSTEES PASS MORATORIUM TO ALLOW FOR STUDY OF FUTURE DEVELOPEMENT

On June 5, 2006, the Trustees unanimously approved a temporary moratorium on permitting further development within the Village.

The temporary moratorium does not affect residential building permits unless the permit is sought to increase the number of housing units. The moratorium does not affect commercial building permits unless the permit will increase the usable space of the commercial property.

The purpose of the moratorium is to prevent the development of more housing units, subdivisions and increased commercial development until the Trustees can study and implement appropriate safeguards to insure that future development will enhance the quality of life of Village residents. The moratorium is consistent with the overall planning being studied by the Board of Trustees.

The moratorium will last a minimum of six (6) months. While the moratorium does not effect residential building permits, residents may call the building department to discuss any plans they might have to increase the size of their homes.
